Didactic Regulations

Departments and Clinics of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care

- 1. The Chair and Department of Anesthesiology and Intensive Therapy performs planned didactic tasks in accordance with the study schedule at individual Faculties of the Medical University of Wroclaw.
- 2. Depending on the subject classes include: lectures, exercises and seminars.
- 3. Participation in classes covered by the study plans is obligatory and controlled.
- 4. The condition to receive credit for the course is to attend all classes in accordance with the Study Regulations. In the case of an excused absence the student is obligated to make up the classes after prior agreement with the teaching adjunct. Each absence must be made up, including rector days and dean's hours the way and form of doing the classes after prior arrangement with a teaching adjunct.
- 5. The form and criteria for passing the classes are given at the beginning of the classes by the teacher.
- 6. Completion of the course is based on:
- a. Checking attendance at classes
- b. Student's knowledge control
- 7. The scope of knowledge to pass the course includes:
- a. The knowledge provided during lectures, exercises, seminars
- b. The knowledge contained in the indicated literature.
- 8. Completion of the subject covered by the exam is made on the basis of credits for all forms of classes conducted as part of the subject and a positive exam grade.
- 9. A student who did not pass the classes has the right to pass the classes at the Head of the Chair and Clinic of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care or a person appointed by him.
